

The River Camel



The River Camel is a river in Cornwall, England, United Kingdom. It rises on the edge of Bodmin Moor and with its tributaries its catchment area covers much of North Cornwall. The River Camel is full of wonders from source to sea: from the beautiful and often protected wildlife that it sustains, like otters, bullheads, salmon and kingfishers. The source of the River Camel is located at Hendraburnick Down on the edge of Bodmin Moor and the catchment area covers a kilometre square. The river rises on Bodmin Moor and reaches the sea about thirty miles later. As part of BBC One's series Nature of Britain, Presenter Sam Smith visited the River Camel to meet the volunteers giving it a new lease of life.
